Become Precinct Officer!

If you are a registered voter in Fresno County and are looking for an opportunity to serve your community, Fresno County requests your participation in serving as a Precinct Officer in upcoming elections. We strongly encourage people who speak Spanish, Japanese, Chinese, Khmer or Hindi to apply.

Who can apply?

- You must be a registered voter in the State of California or a legal permanent resident living in California;
- If you are 16 years of age, a Junior or Senior in high school, in good standing with a GPA of 2.5 or better and with permission from parent and teacher/counselor;
- Fluently read and write English;
- Attend a 2 hour mandatory training;
- Have transportation to and from the polling place and a telephone.

Duties:

- Prepare, open, and close the polling place location;
- Locate voter names on the roster (list of voters living in the precinct);
- Issue and receive official ballots from voters;
- Assist voters in any phase of the voting process.

Hours, Positions & Pay:

- 6:00 a.m. – 9:30 p.m. (approximately, until all duties are completed)
- Inspectors (must have experience) = \$175
- Clerks = \$150
- Vote by Mail Clerks/Precinct Guides = \$150
