

# Route 180 – New Traffic Pattern

Beginning Thursday, November 10 at 5 a.m., a new traffic pattern will be in effect on State Route 180 just east of the 180/99 connector in Fresno, as part of High Speed Rail’s “Fresno Trench” project. For the next five months, one westbound lane on State Route 180 will be shifted over the eastbound side of the highway.

A new speed limit will be in effect for this area and new signs will be posted to alert drivers to the traffic pattern.
