After the race, activities enjoyed by festival goers included the Reptile Ron Animal Presentations, Arts and Crafts vendors, the Kid Zone featuring bounce houses and an obstacle course, Salsa Tasting, and more. This year's festival goers enjoyed entertainment provided by R & L Music Entertainment, Folklorico Dancers, and a crowd-pleasing Car Show.


