DUI/Driver's License Checkpoint Results

Kerman, Calif. – On Saturday, September 20th, 2025, the Kerman Police Department conducted a DUI/Driver's License Checkpoint on Madera Avenue in the City of Kerman as part of our ongoing efforts to keep our roads safe. During the event our officers successfully completed:

- 17 Standardized Field Sobriety Tests (SFSTs)
- 9 Total Citations Issued
- 7 Unlicensed Drivers *CVC12500(a)*
- 4 DUI Arrests
- 4 Vehicles Towed
- 2 Citations for Open Container
- 1 Suspended License (Service Needed) *CVC 14601(a)*

The Kerman Police Department is committed to taking impaired drivers off the road and reminding countless others to drive sober. Driving under the influence is not only dangerous, but also has major consequences. Drivers charged with a first-time DUI face an average of \$13,500 in fines and penalties, as well as a suspended license.

Kerman Police Department will be holding a series of DUI enforcement patrols throughout the year to keep our roadways safe.
