- Keep porches well lit and visible.
- Install a doorbell camera or motion light.

## CRIME PREVENTION TIPS FOR THE NEW YEAR

### Home Security

- Lock all doors and windows.
- Add security cameras or video doorbells.
- Secure gates with locks or latches.
- Install motion-sensor lights around your home.

### Neighborhood Awareness

- Get to know your neighbors.
- Report suspicious behavior right away.
- Keep emergency numbers handy.
- Share safety tips within your neighborhood.

### General Crime Prevention

- If you see something, say something.
- Keep serial numbers for valuable items.
- Mark belongings with identifying info.
- Secure bikes and scooters with strong locks.
- Stay connected with local police updates.

### Vehicle Safety

- Always lock your vehicle.
- Remove valuables from your car.
- Never leave your keys inside.
- Install a steering wheel lock.
- Don't leave mail or documents in your car.
- Use anti-theft devices if available.
- Park in well lit areas.
- Close windows and sunroofs fully.

### Online & Digital Safety

- Update passwords for the new year.
- Enable two-factor authentication.
- Watch out for scams or phishing emails.
- Keep your devices updated.
- Avoid posting when you're away from home.

### PLEASE SEE TIPS BELOW:

- Wear a helmet (Required for riders under 18 on bikes, e-bikes & scooters).
- Follow traffic laws (Ride with traffic and obey signals/stop signs).
- Use lights at night (White front light, red rear reflector/light).
- Don't ride on sidewalks-where prohibited (Use bike lanes when available).
- No passengers on e-bikes or scooters unless the bike is built for it.
- Stay alert! (No headphones in both ears and avoid distractions).
- Know your e-bike class (Class 3 requires riders to be 16+ and wear a helmet).

## Code Compliance & Enforcement Division

The goal of the Code Compliance & Enforcement Division is to obtain voluntary compliance with the regulatory provisions set forth in the City of Kerman Municipal Code. The Division recognizes the importance of maintaining quality of life and protecting the health, safety, and welfare of the public. Some of the most common complaints we receive from residents are:

- Overgrown vegetation
- Open storage, junk, and garbage located in front yards
- Improper storage of trailers, boats, and RV's on private property and public streets
- Unpermitted yard or garage sales and posted illegal yard sale signs
- Inoperative vehicles on private property and public streets.
- Unpermitted accessory structures (i.e. patio covers, carports, sheds, etc.) within setbacks
- Unpermitted home businesses
