Kerman Moves Forward on Area Multi-Generational Center

In November 2023, the City of Kerman received a \$7.25 million grant from the California Department of Food and Agriculture to support construction of the Kerman Area Multi-Generational Resiliency Center. This award represents a major step forward, though it is only part of the total estimated project cost of \$16.38 million. To secure the remaining funding, the City partnered with municipal financial advisor Fieldman, Rolapp & Associates Inc. to identify additional financing strategies and ensure the grant award is protected.

On November 12, 2025, the City Council approved a professional services agreement with ELS Architect and Urban Design to complete the architectural concept plan. This marks an exciting milestone as the project moves from vision to design.

Community Workshops

Public input is essential to shaping the future of this Center. Beginning in January 2026, the City will host a series of three community workshops:

- January 21, 2026 – Gallery Walk/Open House at the Kerman Community Center
- February 18, 2026 – Community Workshop #2
- March 18, 2026 – Community Workshop #3

These sessions will allow residents to share ideas and feedback. Community input will directly inform the design and functionality of the Center, which will serve as the future home of older adult programs, recreation activities, and multi-generational services. The Kerman Area Multi-Generational Resiliency Center will be a place for all ages — a hub for recreation, connection, and resilience. By working together, we are building a space that reflects the needs and values of our community.



A New Chapter for Downtown Kerman

On Wednesday, July 16, 2025, the City of Kerman unveiled two murals as part of the Downtown Corridor Revitalization Project dedication. This project brought to life elements of the Madera Avenue Streetscape Master Plan, completed more than a decade ago. The plan identified specific improvements to enhance roadway safety, mobility, accessibility, and aesthetics — all of which are now being realized. With support from the Caltrans Clean California initiative and Measure M, the City has completed key components of the Master Plan to revitalize a stretch of State Route 145 (Madera Avenue) from State Route 180, through the downtown corridor, to C Street.

Improvements completed included installing benches and trash receptacles, planting new trees and installing tree planters, installing irrigation systems, removing median turf, and installing wayfinding signage. In addition to these streetscape improvements, the project featured decorative banners and art installations that highlight Kerman's rich history and culture. Two murals in the downtown corridor, the Kerman letters, and a historical mural of Kerman's past and present. The Downtown Corridor Revitalization Project enhances the heart of our city — making it safer, more accessible, and more welcoming for residents and visitors alike. This dedication ceremony was not only a celebration of infrastructure improvements but also of community pride and cultural expression.



POOL RULES

- All persons must shower before entering the pool.
- All children under the age of 8 must be supervised by a responsible person at least 14 years of age. Persons having open blisters, cuts, etc., are advised not to use the pool.
- Zero tolerance for fighting and graffiti.
- No gang related paraphernalia.
- Proper swim attire must be worn. No cut-off shorts, sweats or pants will be allowed in the pool.
- Babies must wear Water Diapers in pool.
- Obey Lifeguards at all times.
- No public displays of affection in facility.
- No running.
- No rough play, pushing, or dunking.
- No foul language.
- No T-Shirts are allowed in the deep end.
- No floatation devices, snorkels, or fins are allowed in the pool.
- No diving in small pool or shallow end of big pool.
- No alcohol, drugs, or smoking in facility.
- No gum allowed in pool area.
- No glass containers allowed.

LESSON DESCRIPTIONS

ME & MY SHADOW: To familiarize children from 1-3 years old to the water and teach swimming readiness skills. Fee includes parent and child.

POLYWOG: To familiarize children 4-5 years old to the aquatic environment and help them learn basic aquatic skills.

GUPPIES: For children 4-6 years old who are comfortable going under water. This class will build on and improve skills learned in the Polywog level.

MINNOWS: This class is taught in deeper water and is primarily for children 6+ to build on and improve skills learned in the Guppies level.

JELLYFISH: Students must have successfully completed the Minnows level. This class builds on stroke development skills.

One-on-One: Children who are at least 4 years old are taught one-on-one swim instruction. Skills taught in this class are based on the students swimming ability.

2. Attendance at each lesson is important to receive the full benefit of the class. No make-up lessons or credits for missed classes are given.
3. If a class or session is cancelled or postponed the City of Kerman will make every effort to make-up during an alternate time, parents will be notified.
4. Students may only participate in the class and time slot they are registered for.
5. Transfers between classes will only be allowed if there is room in the class and approved by the Pool Manager on duty.
6. WAITING LISTS: Once a class has reached its limit, a waiting list will be established.
7. REFUNDS: No refunds unless the class is cancelled by the City of Kerman.

“B” STREET PARK - “B” Street & 16th Street

This 1 acre park features a large grass area, trees, picnic benches, and lights. The park’s composite playground features 3 slides, climbers and a musical panel. B Street park serves as the local neighborhood, and is an ideal location for an afternoon of reading, relaxing, or studying. The large grassy area can also be used for a game of catch, throwing a Frisbee, or a pick-up game of soccer.

KATEY’S KIDS PARK - 245 S. Park Avenue

This 2.84 acre park features a park/play environment that allows children and families to experience the many benefits of recreating in a natural setting. Park amenities include a playground, hill climbing wall & slide, water feature, natural paths, interpretive trail, picnic areas, lots of trees, open grass area and restroom. This neighborhood park is named in honor of Katey Sebastian, who devoted her life to the improvement of the lives of the children in her community through literacy, education and community development.

KERCKHOFF PARK - 15061 W. “G” Street

This 5.75 acre park features a stage and dance area, softball/baseball field with spectator bleachers and score board, restrooms, picnic benches, picnic tables, and lighting. The park’s large composite playground features a twisty slide, monkey-bars, jungle gyms, and slides. Kerckhoff Park’s Scout Hut facility is available as a private rental facility. Kerckhoff Park is also home to the Skate Park.

KIWANIS PARK - S. Merlot and W. San Joaquin

This 2.12 acre park features a large, fenced green area with softball/baseball field and picnic benches. The children’s playground includes a toddler play area, as well as a composite playground, with slides, monkey-bars, swings, a twisty slide, a half basketball court and lights. Kiwanis Park is handicap accessible.

LIONS PARK - “E” Street & Park Avenue

This 18 acre park is home to the Kerman Youth Soccer League. Lions Park features two softball/baseball fields, restrooms, a covered pavilion area with electricity, picnic tables, BBQ pit, three horseshoe pits, basketball court, and paved parking. The Lions Park Picnic Pavilion is a covered structure that seats 96 guests.

PHILIP GALLEGOS PLAY PARK - Melody & North Koleen Avenue

This 1.25 acre neighborhood park is Kerman’s newest park located in the Crown Homes Subdivision on Siskiyou and Highway 180 (Whitesbridge Rd.) Park amenities include park benches, walking path, picnic tables, pet litter stations, musical instruments and playground structure.

PLAZA VETERANS PARK - Madera Avenue

This 3.3 acre park was Kerman’s first park and is now a beautiful focal point at Kerman’s South entrance. The park features a restroom, park benches, walking paths, picnic tables, lighting and a canopy structure. A Veteran’s Circle of Honor pays tribute to those men and women who have bravely served our country. The park’s mature pine trees command admiration, and also provide shade throughout the park.

ROTARY PARK - “D” Street & Vineland

This 4.9 acre park is home to the Kerman Cal Ripken Baseball League. Rotary Park features two softball/baseball fields equipped with field lighting, spectator seating, park space, restrooms, and a concession facility. The large green area can also be used as a football or soccer field. Rotary Park also features a large playground area, with swings, slides, a jungle gym, and a small rock-climbing wall.

SKATE PARK - 15061 W. “G” Street

The park boasts 13,000 square feet of smooth cement surfacing with steel skate ramps. The facility is fenced and lighted, and includes a spectator viewing area. Helmets are required, and safety rules are strictly enforced.

SOROPTIMIST PARK - W. Kearney & Siskiyou

This 2.14 acre park is 100% handicap accessible. The innovative playground equipment allows a child in a wheelchair to ascend up the playground ramp simultaneously with another child. The playground also boasts a rubber poured-in-place surfacing, small grass area, beautiful landscaping, musical instruments, picnic benches, picnic tables, antique-style lighting, wrought iron fencing, and shelter structures.

TRINI’S PARK - W. Stanislaus & McKenna

This 1.9 acre park features the first ever spray ground and exercise equipment. Other amenities include modern theme playground equipment, half basketball court, picnic shelter, solar lighting, restroom and large grass area.

WOOTEN PARK - Wooten Drive & “C” Street

This 1.5 acre park features a large grass area with a softball/baseball field, trees, picnic benches, picnic tables and lighting. The park is also home to the John Triantis playground, which includes slides, monkey-bars, spring-riders, climbing volcano and a tire swing.
